MY TESTIMONY

Jeremiah 33:3 KJVS [3] Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not

Contrary to what you do, how you have lived and what you were taught, the Holy Bible is not just a book you mindlessly read. In actuality, the Bible is a book full of secrets, mysteries, and wonders. It is essential to read the Bible to understand the hidden mysteries and secrets that can only be revealed through wisdom from the Holy Spirit, who reveals to men the mysteries and great and mighty things in the Bible.

John 9:39 KJVS [39] And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

The majority of humans, who are born and live on Earth, are blind, we do not see, hear or understand. We live our lives in a semi-conscious state, as if we were senseless beings. We go from routine to routine blindly accepting what others teach us, and conform to what we are told, we do not ask for wisdom to understand the "why" of all things. More importantly, though many of us are Christians, we fail to recognize that the answer to **everything** is specifically and completely laid out in the Bible.

Although we hear the question often posed, we never truly ask ourselves: Who are we? Where do we come from? Where are we going? Why were we born in this flesh of sin and death? Why do we delight in evil? What were we before Earth began? Is there even such a thing?

In many ways we are like foolish creatures going from day to day, we do not truly ask ourselves these questions or reason their logic. Even sadder yet, we do not read the Scripture to fill us with the answer to these things. Thus, we live in a state of **ignorance**, blind to what is the truth, blind to His Word.

Lies and deceit are the deadliest and most astute weapons the enemy has used and continues to use to blind us so that the light of understanding of the Holy Word will not shine in us (*Isaiah 59:10*). The enemy, through dressing like an angel of light, has robbed us of the truth and hidden the legitimacy of the reason why we are on Earth, how we got here and why God is so merciful. With this in mind, I want to tell you a story that will sound very strange to you at first. Your natural reaction may be to stay away from it and it is, indeed, very difficult for many to believe but it is a conclusive truth to a few of us

who truly read and understand the scripture. Our Lord Jesus Christ tells us and through Him lets us see the true history of the world and all who live in it, not simply what the world has taught us. (*John* 9:39,14:6).

This is the true story of the world and all who live in it:

Colossians 2:2-3 KJVS

[2] <u>That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;</u>
 [3] In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

One day, before Earth began, there was a beautiful kingdom where peace and love reigned and abundance resounded. A kingdom where need did not exist there was no need. The King of that kingdom had publicly declared, in His own word and as a statute of truth, that He was good and that His kingdom would be one of mercy and justice forever. Both nature and the beings of that wonderful place rejoiced together on account of the words of that good King. These divine words filled the entire kingdom with peace.

Like with all kingdoms, there were ranks; there were those who were leaders of the people, of the nations, principalities and governors. These leaders were those which the King loved and whom He gave wisdom to govern. They were more intelligent than the others. (*Genesis 3:1*) The wonderful words (that He was good and that His kingdom would be one of mercy and justice forever), were the foundation stone upon which the whole kingdom was based. And the King, forever bound Himself to these Words as His command, that He could do no harm or evil and would forever have mercy.

Sadly, some of those leaders took advantage of the benign decree of the good King. They knew His words were faithful, true and would be fulfilled completely and specifically as stated from the moment when they were publicly decreed. Since the King had publicly declared He was good, then no harm could ever come from the King, even to those who rebelled against Him. To them, the King had exposed His kingdom and left it defenseless without a way out. Through a series of bad decisions and plots and schemes many turned and conspired against the good King. They agreed and publicly declared their independence. (*Ezekiel 28:5-18*)

Evil took over their hearts and with wrongful pursuit they pillaged the kingdom and established a "new one." They invited all who wanted to be part of their rebellion to join in their desire to be self ruled, self-governed, free from the King, their own "king." They claimed that in this way they could explore all the pleasures of sin, without fear or respect of nothing or no one. (*Romans 8:7*)

Since the King had declared himself good and since no harm or punishment could befall them, they rebelled against all good: Good does no evil or harm. They destroyed peace, and did as they pleased. (*Matthew 11:12; Romans 1:18-23*)

The King was heartbroken because, despite the fact that He loved them, they had betrayed Him and in their sin they had managed to convince one third of the people of the kingdom and dragged them to the opposite of good, causing them all who joined to be cursed, addicted to evil. (*Revelation 12:4*)

The King had a serious dilemma, not because His Kingdom was under threat, He had His loyal army, which could easily destroy the rebellion instantly. (*Matthew 26:53*) His problem was that he loved the one-third that had rebelled and, due to His love for them, and on account of the decree of His word, He had to convince them and prevail with good, not harm. (*Psalm 100:5*) For a limited time He let them build and live out their fantasy and He allowed them to take their own decisions and choices between good and evil and they were allowed to be self-governed "kings" in their own right. (*Hebrews 11:25*)

While they delighted in the evil they practiced with each other, the good King disguised Himself as one of them, and He came to their cities and towns. (*John 1:14*) He came as what He truly was, as good, yet they did not recognize Him and they took advantage of the good King. (*John 1:10 and 11*) They beat, tortured, humiliated and killed Him without realizing that the good King was there simply because He loved them and to honor the truth of His Word, to test it, to prove that His Word was, is and will always be the rock of good on which His whole kingdom is built. (*John 3:16*) Jesus Christ is not only the incarnation of God, but He is in actuality the Word of God personified, actualized and materialized. He is the living Word of God that came to test and prove God's faithful and merciful decree. He proved to the world that God is good, full of mercy and salvation. We saw the Word, He came to Earth and ultimately we crucified Him, proving to the World, Universe and all creation that God's Word, prevailed through life, death and remains true in victory. (*Romans 8:29; Ephesians 1:3-4; Titus 1:2; 1 Peter 1:20*)

Isaiah 53:3-7 KJVS

[3] He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
[4] Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

[5] But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. [6] All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

[7] He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

On account of the great love that He has for us, He decided to send His Word to Earth to be proven true to all of us. (Acts 4:11)

Let me ask you: do you ever wonder why you were born in this flesh of sin? All of us who are born in the flesh, we are the one third part of the stars that originally rebelled against the good King, before the creation of the Earth. (*Isaiah 64:6*) We are here living

out our fantasy, to be like gods in our own right, trapped by the desires of our flesh, (*John* 10:34), engaging and deciding between good and evil. The saddest part of this story is that many of us, to this day, continue revel in the evil of our original sin. The story of Earth does not begin with Adam and Eve. That is in fact the beginning of Earth, but the Bible is very clear that salvation was created **before Earth**, it is a plan that was set in place before to save that which was lost. (*Ephesians* 1:3-4; *Romans* 8:29)

We blame Adam and Eve because they ate the forbidden fruit and we do the exact same thing that they did when we practice evil. We also, being part flesh, together with them and all humanity: we beat, tortured, humiliated and crucified Him when we do not believe in the truth of the Word written in His Holy Bible. We are here just like the prodigal son: We are far from home, due to the multitude of our bad decisions and schemes in which we engaged before the creation of the Earth. (2 Corinthians 5:2).

Let us recognize our faults and let us fall down on our knees, in humbleness and humiliation before our Mighty Creator and the boundless mercy of His Word, whom we mercilessly crucified, despite the fact that He was innocent like a child. (*Matthew 3:2*) Let us ask for forgiveness from our hearts recognizing that He is righteous and true. (*Joel* 2:13) Recognizing that through Jesus He has honored and accomplished His Word and put His Word as the founding rock of all creation (that mercy and justice will reign eternally, this is the foundation of grace)

Let us recognize the truth, that God in all His mercy is good and that Christ came to prove that God is good. Consider this, that Christ subjected himself to all kinds of humiliation, even to be tempted by satan himself, whom *He defeated only with good*. To the world, this was impossible. (*Matthew 4:1-11*) To the world (*Psalm 83:5*), evil can only be defeated with evil, just like we do today, we subjugate rebellion with war and war with more war. The only way we know to defeat a threat is to destroy it, to harm it, to kill it. The world never imagined that evil could ever be defeated with good. Blessed be His Holy Word and the Word of His Holy Majesty, Amen. (*Revelation 4:11*)

Colossians 2:15 KJVS [15] And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

I had never understood this wonderful passage. I had not understood why God Almighty allowed himself to be subject to all kind of humiliation, beatings, to the shadow of death and ultimately to a brutally painful death were He shed His blood to cleanse our sin. What more proof of good is this? That He laid down His life for His friends (John 10:11, 15:13) but even more so, that God laid down His life for those who had declared himself His enemies. If you truly are able to understand this, it touches your soul, and shakes your core on account of the guilt. There is no place in our hearts or minds that can truly comprehend or sustain the insurmountable love that God has towards all His creation, the good and sinners alike. Even the powers and principalities of evil were defeated with good, and with the truthful honor of His Word, that He is just and forever has eternal mercy. Amen. (*Psalm 37:27*)

Matthew 21:42-45 KJVS

[42] Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, <u>The stone which the</u> builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

[43] Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, <u>and given to</u> <u>a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof.</u>

[44] <u>And whosoever shall fall on this stone shall be broken</u>: but on whomsoever it shall fall, it will grind him to powder.

[45] And when the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, <u>they perceived</u> that he spake of them.

Read, and understand. The Word is clear: "Anyone who falls on this rock will be broken;" All who truly are Christians, in heart and not just words, are Christians because they have truly understood. And with this understanding are broken and contrite in Spirit, because we recognize that <u>before the creation of this Earth</u> we had rebelled against good, the reason why we were deprived of the Glory of God. If we truly understand this, then we hurt and are ashamed by it because we realize we not only sinned against God in His Holy Kingdom before Earth, (*Romans 3:23*), but we continued in our rebellion to this day. (*Hosea 6:7*)

You might wonder how, if God is good, He punished us by throwing us (the rebellious 1/3) to Earth? You might think, "if He is good, how did He throw us out of His glory and to Earth (*Romans 3:23*)" The answer is that good and bad do not mix. Simply by declaring himself good, the bad was automatically excluded outcast and impossible to be part of the light. (*2 Corinthians 6:14*) Similar to a negative/positive charge that repel each other, light and darkness likewise repel and by declaring Himself good, all that is evil repelled to the opposite and did not have a place in heaven but in His infinite mercy he made us from the dust which we had been turned into before the creation of the world (Genesis 1:2,3-4). We were made in the image of Him (His son) who was to come to give us a second chance to be purified through the Spirit with sacrifice as partakers of flesh and blood (*Isaiah 48:10 / Isaiah 48:10*) until we again reach the full measure of the image of Christ. (*Ephesians 4:13*) God disciplines and purifies us so that we return, polished without blemish, white as snow. (*Isaiah 1:16-19 / Daniel 11:35; 2 Timothy 2:6 / Matthews 21:43-44; John 1:5*)

Do not be in ignorance. The teachings of this World hide the truth from your eyes and in turn, your heart cannot see. **How do you know if you are still in this state of ignorance** that the Bible talks about? It is something you feel. A palpable change and transformation that our lives undergo. When through wisdom of the Holy Spirit living in us, we understand how evil operates in our lives, and how it has dominion over our human nature and flesh. When our eyes are opened and we understand, we undergo a drastic transformation, we are not the same person that we were before. Once we understand, we live in harmony and in accordance with the Holy Spirit, not the flesh. (*Romans 3:4-7*) It is not only a change that others see in us, but we also feel different, not only to ourselves, but to others as well. (Faith is not seen, but felt). For example, the friends we use to have when we lived according to the flesh no longer connect or understand us. We may even disconnect from our own family members who are not living according to the Holy Spirit. Of course, they do not understand us; they criticize us, as we are different. The truth is that when we gain this wisdom and truly understand the Bible, our purpose and

the Truth, we die to the world, we die to our old life and our only desire becomes the love and service of God, our Creator.

The Holy Scripture, instead of being full of stories and rules, becomes something desirable and wonderful to our mind, eyes and ears and we long to read and learn. The more we learn and read, the closer we get to become more like Christ. (*Ephesians 4:13*) Our desire is to pray at all times, pleading for our family and friends and the souls of all of those people who have not yet been called to understanding. We long to communicate in the Holy Spirit and peace of Christ. Glory to God, our Creator!

1 Peter 1:15-19 KJVS

[15] But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation;

[16] Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.

[17] <u>And if ye call on the Father</u>, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:

[18] Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; [19] But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

Now that we understand a little more as to whether we are or are not walking in the **path** of **ignorance**, ask yourself the following:

Have you felt a drastic change in your life? Do you feel different than others? Have you renounced and rejected the ways of this world or died to this world? Are you still the same as you were before?

If not, then you are still in a **state of ignorance** and you urgently need to ask for spiritual wisdom. You need to ask for wisdom in order to understand with your Spirit. If you truly want to change, talk to God from your heart and not just from your lips. Listen to and pay special attention to each word that comes from your lips, say them with courage, feel them as if they were alive like flying doves coming from your mouth so that they may reach the throne of grace of God and so that they are not dead empty words that are swept away by the wind.

Let us renounce ourselves saying:

Psalm 119:124-125 KJVS

[124] Deal with thy servant according unto thy mercy, and teach me thy statutes. [125] I am thy servant; give me understanding, that I may know thy testimonies.

There are probably many of us who are dominated by pride. We think that because we have read and studied more than others, that this doesn't apply, that we know enough and we understand all we need to understand. Let me remind you that even the disciples/apostles, when they were engaging with Christ while He was on Earth, read and failed to understand the scripture.

It is my prayer that Christ Jesus, the Living Word of God Almighty, will open your eyes of understanding today:

Ephesians 1:17-19 KJVS

[17] That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

[18] <u>The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the</u> <u>hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,</u> [19] <u>And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according</u> <u>to the working of his mighty power</u>

I have changed my life and will never be the same again and, moved by the Holy Spirit, I would like to publicly state, that like all men, I have sinned against God and His wonderful creation. Even if I have not directly practiced evil I recognize that I have offended many of those who have been part of my life. A life that is in itself an hour of trial which we all go through and lasts approximately 40 to 45 conscious years (given that the other half of our lives is spent sleeping.) I publicly ask for forgiveness, first to God and to anyone else whom I have offended with my actions and words, "forgive me."

I also publicly state that I have come to truly understand why I am stuck living in this body's flesh of sin and I am ashamed. I am what I am due to my previous transgressions and sinned, those in which I originally rebelled against God. (*Romans 3:23*)

It is through my understanding of the Holy word of God Almighty that He has shown me the truth and removed the deception in which I lived: Deception that was shaped by and in accordance to the standards of this society and this world. (2 Corinthians 4:4)

Through His boundless compassion and mercy, I can say today, that God has forgiven me all of my past sins and all the sins I committed in the flesh in which I still live. (*Proverbs* 1:23)

Psalm 32:1-2 KJVS

[1] Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. [2] Blessed is the man unto whom the Lord imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.

If you still do not understand this marvelous act that God did for us, and if you still identify and side with evil and practice evil, or if you practice evil and Sunday you go to church, let me remind you that God is good but no one can deceive Him. He himself said:

Revelation 3:15-16 KJVS

[15] I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.[16] So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth.

Do not lie to yourself thinking that simply because you go to church you are saved. You have to read and ask for spiritual wisdom and guidance to understand God's Holy Word. Do not forget that satan himself tempted Christ with words written in the Holy Bible. This shows us that he had read the Bible, but he failed to understand it. This is the same as many of us today. We read the Holy Scripture like it is an obligation or simply to wash our hands like Pontius Pilate did, but we do not understand them with our Spirit.

Matthew 7:21-27 KJVS

[21] Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

[22] Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? [23] And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

[24] Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

[25] <u>And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon</u> that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

[26] And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

[27] And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

Now that you have heard these hidden mysteries, **what will you do from now on**? **On which foundation will you build your knowledge**? If we look at the world we live in, the flood waters have risen and the levies broken, and soon the devouring fire will also come to consume (*2 Peter 3:10-11*). [4] But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

[5] Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple,

[6] And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.

[7] Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. [8] Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

[9] And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.

[10] Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

[11] Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

[5] For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee:

Revelation 4:11 KJVS

[11] Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Psalm 37:27 KJVS

[27] Depart from evil, and do good; and dwell for evermore.

Isaiah 48:14 KJVS

[14] All ye, assemble yourselves, and hear; which among them hath declared these things ? The Lord hath loved him: he will do his pleasure on Babylon, and his arm shall be on the Chaldeans.

2 Peter 3:10-11 KJVS

[10] But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

[11] Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,

Romans 1:18-23 KJVS

[18] For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

[19] Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them.

[20] For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

[21] Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

[22] Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

[23] And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things.

[10] Behold, I have refined thee, but not with silver; I have chosen thee in the furnace of affliction.

Zechariah 13:9 KJVS

[9] And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, The Lord is my God.
