Searching for a Miracle

There are immeasurable miracles around us that we fail to appreciate... Creation itself, right before your very eyes, daily within your reach, is a miracle (*Romans 1:19-20*). We have been improperly taught to see all these precious miracles that surround us as commonalities.

A tree for example:

Was born

Lived and

Died

To serve you, and you did not know it, realize it and you never asked yourself about it, nor was it relevant in your mind. What a shame.

From such a tiny seed, comes out a giant, elegant tree full of life and spectacular colors that enrich and delight your soul and the body of every living being. Trees know that we are blind and so they paint their fruit with brilliant colors so to call our attention when we are hungry and in turn fulfill our needs.

We sleep under their shade, they blow a breeze on us with their branches which at the same time also clean our air. They line the streets and parks anxiously waiting, just like a slave waits for its king, to serve you. Even with their death they cover our roofs, our floors, our walls. They protect and guard our homes and then we throw them in the fire and still they keep us warm, light our kitchens and ultimately we reduce them to ashes. And all this time we did not realize that this tree was born, lived and died to serve you.

Let me tell you that all of creation was made to serve you. Slow down for a moment, stop your routine and look around. You are like a king and <u>all</u> of creation is your slave, designed according to your needs. It is not like they teach us that everything evolves. (*Isaiah 66:17*). If such were the case, then naturally things would not evolve to serve us as they are and have always done. They (the society of this world *Psalm 83:4,5*) have divided up creation in exchange for a price and for money (*1 Timothy 6: 7,8,9,10*). Yet, as God has promised in His Holy Scripture, this usurpation of creation wont be forever.

Our God is not a God of the dead but of the living.

Romans 14:9 KJVS

[9] For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and living.

Matthew 22:31-33 KJVS

- [31] But as touching the resurrection of the dead, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying,
- [32] I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living.
- [33] And when the multitude heard this, they were astonished at his doctrine.

I cried when I finally understood this wonderful miracle. It is a miracle to understand that the dead will resurrect and even more to understand that God says: *I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.* God says that <u>He is</u> a God of those, whom to our eyes, already died long ago and yet He says it, not in the past tense, but the present, which affirms that they are not dead, but rather, are presently living. Halleluiah!

I had read these passages many times but I had never understood them. When I understood it was a marvel, something awakened in me, I sprang to life from my sentence of death...because we all face death and we are afraid of the unknown, but God says "*God is not the God of the dead, but of the living*." You and I live to enjoy and cheerfully share that we are alive. Amen! During my life, I have been born again, and I have died to the world and its wicked ways because I now understand that Christ Jesus paid for my life and like Paul said:

Galatians 2:20 KJVS

[20] I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

The miracle of life is not just to live in the flesh for the flesh is dead. The true miracle of life is to live in the Spirit, because the Spirit is eternal.

Naturally your question is "How do we accomplish this?" Let me tell you, this is the easiest part to answer.

How wonderful, how much love, what an awesome gift.

John 3:16-17 KJVS

[16] For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
[17] For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

God, our Father, Creator and Savior made Eternal Salvation so easy for the gentiles that whoever fails to recognize it does not do so in ignorance, but is willingly stubborn given that it is so simple that even a child can understand it.

Let us read:

Romans 10:9 KJVS

[9] That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

- 1. [C]onfess with thy mouth
- 2. The Lord Jesus
- 3. Believing that God raised Him from the dead

You will be saved: not with sacrifice or payment or contract. It is a free gift though you were condemned to die, and through His grace, His power and love, He gave you eternal life. Amen. (*Isaiah 55:1-2*)

Who really wants to go to hell? No one. Many, however, do not take death seriously until they come close to it, such as when a friend, family member or acquaintance dies. This is when they ask, "Who is next?"

If you are looking for a miracle like most people (who are lost, hurt, sick, terminally ill, sad, carrying baggage, carrying grief, prisoners, condemned to die, lonely, in distress, without hope, whatever your situation may be) let me reassure you that you can do everything through Jesus Christ:

Philippians 4:4,6-7,10,13,19-20 KJVS

- [4] Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, Rejoice.
- [6] Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.
- [7] And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- [10] But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath flourished again; wherein ye were also careful, **but ye lacked opportunity**.
- [13] I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.
- [19] But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.
- [20] Now unto God and our Father be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Give your life to Christ and He will take care of you. Do not put your faith in the science of men (1 Timothy 6:20), because their path is a path of death, without any hope. Remember that God is a God of the living (Romans 14:9) and He

made us a work of His hands and thus the only miracle that can save your life is Christ Jesus. (*Psalm 111:7*; *Ephesians 2:10*)

Ecclesiastes 2:22-26 KJVS

- [22] For what hath man of all his labour, and of the vexation of his heart, wherein he hath laboured under the sun?
- [23] For all his days are sorrows, and his travail grief; yea, his heart taketh not rest in the night. This is also vanity.
- [24] There is nothing better for a man, than that he should eat and drink, and that he should make his soul enjoy good in his labour. This also I saw, that it was from the hand of God.
- [25] For who can eat, or who else can hasten hereunto, more than I?
 [26] For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God. This also is vanity and vexation of spirit.

All, absolutely all, the toils and cares of this life are vanity, because they all end with death and:

Job 1:21 KJVS

[21] And said, **Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither:** the Lord gave, and the Lord hath taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord.

Ecclesiastes 5:15 KJVS

[15] As he came forth of his mother's womb, naked shall he return to go as he came, and shall take nothing of his labour, which he may carry away in his hand.

2 Corinthians 5:2-3 KJVS

- [2] For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:
- [3] If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

Let us remember what happened in the garden of Eden with Adam and Eve when they disobeyed God and ate the forbidden fruit:

Genesis 2:25 KJVS

[25] And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

Genesis 3:7,9-11 KJVS

- [7] And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.
 [9] And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?
 [10] And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.
- [11] And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

Revelation 16:15 KJVS

[15] Behold, I come as a thief. <u>Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his</u> garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

All of us in this world have fear, and generally, we are ashamed of nakedness. Nakedness signifies exposing ourselves or making others know our inner, intimate secrets, our forbidden fruit, our sin.

We similarly expose our nakedness when we are weak; when our power and wealth cannot liberate us from a difficult situation, like a terminal illness or a problem that cannot be resolved with money. In that kind of situation we become dressed with sadness, bitterness and pain. The wares of this life overwhelm us and we clothe ourselves with tiredness, solitude, loneliness, weeping and we take refuge in vices, addictions and cover ourselves with the fig leaves of evil.

Others involuntarily clothe themselves with mourning and sadness covers us and life breaks us with death and we fall in this cavern of emptiness. We become trapped and condemned by the prisons of this world, accused by the law and condemned by the justice of men, waiting for the moment of the death penalty condemned by those who consider themselves just.

What we clothe ourselves in accuses and exposes us before God and men. Evil spirits take advantage of us because they recognize us, what clothes us, and what we reflect in front of us. I am not speaking of physical clothes that you can see and feel. I am speaking of the clothes that are figuratively in front of us declaring who we are and how we want to be seen in front of others.

It is our deeds that cover and expose us. For example, if you like to be perceived as someone with economic power because you have a lot of possessions, then you will be dressed with pride. That pride that clothes you will separate you from others who, in turn, are dressed with poverty, ambition and that wakes a sense of envy which leads us to bad actions which ultimately results in crimes and crimes in death.

If you are a professional, a doctor, then you are clothed in superiority. Which is a wrongful pride we have been taught because a true doctor should always walk dressed in mercy and with hands full of compassion. The world, however, has taught us the opposite. If there is no money in hand, then there is no service, there is not compassion, help, or pity. Money has come to cover everything. (1 Timothy 6:10; Ecclesiastes 5:10).

A Christian should always be dressed with mercy and love, for both the rich and poor. The poor lives covered and oppressed under the shadow of the wicked rich who enslaves him and dressed him with poverty, necessity, anguish, desires, and humiliation simply by looking at the rich. The rich himself is worthy of pity because the material possessions he has are all he will enjoy and it will be a short moment of joy and false hope. Like all, he came into the world naked and naked he will depart and he will go to continued poverty dressed in eternal suffering.

Let us dress in justice which is clothing that comes from God. Let us dress in truth, that is Christ. Let us dress in light because He is the Father of lights. (*James 1:17*). Let the light of Christ walk before us so that our association with others may be a blessing, joy, good news and salvation so that we may not have blemishes. Let our clothing be white and clean so that we have nothing to be ashamed of because in Christ is all that is good and pure:

Psalm 85:10-11 KJVS

- [10] Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other.
- [11] <u>Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down</u> from heaven.

Proverbs 11:19,21 KJVS

- [19] As righteousness tendeth to life: so he that pursueth evil pursueth it to his own death.
- [21] Though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered.

Isaiah 32:17 KJVS

[17] And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.

Matthew 6:25-34 KJVS

- [25] Therefore I say unto you, <u>Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat,</u> or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?
- [26] Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?
- [27] Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?
- [28] And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:
- [29] And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
- [30] Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith?
- [31] Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?
- [32] (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.
- [33] But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.
- [34] Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Something definitely got lost over time. We lost faith, hope, confidence, security and peace. Our past generations were not strong when they built the pillars of our heritage. We were all easily tumbled when the storm came. It tore our foundations because they were not based on the solid rock, the rock of our salvation, but it is never too late for God. He promises that He will raise our walls in the fortress of the Omnipotent, Amen. (Ezekiel 34:16)

Matthew 5:2-12 KJVS

- [2] And he opened his mouth, and taught them, saying,
- [3] Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- [4] Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.
- [5] Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.
- [6] **Blessed** are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: **for they** shall be filled.
- [7] Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy.
- [8] Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
- [9] Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.
- [10] **Blessed** are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: **for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**

- [11] **Blessed** are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.
- [12] Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

John 16:8-13 KJVS

- [8] And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:
- [9] Of sin, because they believe not on me:
- [10] Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more;
- [11] Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged.
- [12] I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.
- [13] Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

And the Spirit of Truth has awakened the word of God, which announces to us that the time is here, so let us prepare because:

Romans 13:12-14 KJVS

- [12] <u>The night is far spent, the day is at hand:</u> let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, **and let us put on the armour of light.**
- [13] Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.
- [14] But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof.

Ephesians 4:22-27,30-32 KJVS

- [22] That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;
- [23] And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
- [24] And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.
- [25] Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.
- [26] Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:
- [27] Neither give place to the devil.
- [30] And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
- [31] Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

[32] And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

Ephesians 6:11-12 KJVS

- [11] <u>Put on the whole armour of God,</u> that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- F[12] For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Colossians 3:12 KJVS

[12] <u>Put on therefore, as the elect of God,</u> holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

Revelation 16:15 KJVS

[15] Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

Psalm 65:4 KJVS

[4] Blessed is the man whom thou choosest, and causest to approach unto thee, that he may dwell in thy courts: we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house, even of thy holy temple.

Psalm 89:15-16 KJVS

- [15] Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O Lord, in the light of thy countenance.
- [16] In thy name shall they rejoice all the day: and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted.

Colossians 3:14-15 KJVS

- [14] And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.
- [15] **And let the peace of God rule in your hearts**, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.

Isaiah 55:1-2 KJVS

- [1] Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.
- [2] Wherefore do ye spend money for that which is not bread? and your labour for that which satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto me, and eat ye that which is good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.

And as I mentioned before: God our Father, Creator and Savior granted eternal salvation to the gentiles in such an easy way that if they do not take it, it is not because they are ignorant, but rather are willfully stubborn because even a child could understand it. (Luke 16:22)

Therefore have faith and you will live, because, our Father Abraham lives and did so from the moment he believed thousands of years ago. And they still live. (*Luke 9:30 RV60; Matthew 17:3*)

[22] And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness.

Romans 10:10-11,13 KJVS

- [10] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.
- [11] For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.
- [13] For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Ephesians 4:23-24 KJVS

- [23] And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;
- [24] And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

2 Peter 3:13 KJVS

[13] Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

Revelation 19:11 KJVS

[11] And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war.

And His fight, He fights for you, for the salvation of your soul. Open your heart and understand that when you deny yourself, you deny Him and you crucify Him, you strike Him, over and over again when He came to save you.

Now clothe yourselves in courage and evaluate your soul, rescue it from the claws of hell. Be your own hero, believing that in Jesus everything is possible if you believe.
